The minor in finance provides non-business majors with an understanding of key finance concepts. Through case studies and company projects, students learn how to apply these concepts to real-life situations. Students also gain insight on financial markets and their wide-ranging impacts.

Required courses

- Introduction to accounting
- Introduction to economics
- Business statistics or any statistics course
- Corporate finance

Electives (choose 2 courses)

- Financial modelling
- Financial risk management
- Financial markets and institutions
- International finance
- Portfolio management
- Options, futures and other derivatives
- Financial statement analysis
- Risk, information and insurance
- Securities market
- Finance in multinational corporations

*In case a required course has already been learnt in the major or in the GE component, students must take one substitute from the minor electives
Students who choose this minor must make sure that they accomplish at least 18 credit hours required for it*
